

# Lieber takes reins at ULI

Longtime member Robert Lieber has been named the new chairman of the Urban Land Institute NY.

Lieber, an former Deputy Mayor for Economic Development and now an executive managing director at Island Capital Group in New York City, said he hoped to use his position to advance a forum for the meeting of minds all working towards the development of New York.

Prior to joining the Bloomberg administration in January 2007, Lieber held executive positions at Lehman Brothers for 23 years. As ULI New York chairman, he will serve on a voluntary basis for a three-year term that starts on July 1.
