

2017 ULI New York Alice Connell WLI Scholarship

Globally introduced in 2012, the Women's Leadership Initiative (WLI) was launched by ULI New York in 2013. The mission of the ULI Women's Leadership Initiative is expressed in four primary objectives:

- **Promote the advancement of women**, throughout their careers, as leaders in the real estate industry.
- **Increase the number of women who serve in leadership positions** in the real estate industry and in ULI.
- **Increase the visibility of women leaders** in the real estate industry and in ULI.
- **Increase the number of women who are active ULI Full Members**, and support the development of young women members as leaders in ULI and in their professions.

ULI New York will award one woman with a scholarship to the Fall Meeting. This is a separate award from the ten WLI scholarships offered by ULI and Prologis at the global level. The ULI New York Alice Connell Scholarship Program is designed to promote the participation of women at the 2017 Fall Meeting in Los Angeles and to promote leadership among younger women who might not otherwise be able to attend.

The recipient of the ULI New York Alice Connell Scholarship will be selected based on the member's ability to articulate how her involvement with ULI New York and her attendance at the Fall Meeting will advance her professional interests and pursuits, as well as her likely future involvement with ULI, globally or at the District Council level.

Requirements:

- Current member of ULI under the age of 35
- Minimum 5 years experience in the real estate or land use industries
- Demonstrated leadership within ULI New York
- Completed application, resume and signed letter of support due **Tuesday, September 5, 2017**

The 2017 ULI New York Alice Connell WLI Scholarship includes complimentary registration to the ULI 2017 Fall Meeting and reimbursement of pre-approved out-of pocket transportation and/or lodging expenses up to \$1,000. Each scholarship recipient will attend all WLI-branded events at the ULI 2017 Fall Meeting, and after the Fall Meeting will prepare a summary of her key takeaways to be posted on the ULI New York website.

Applications should be completed in full and returned with the candidate's resume. Completed applications should be submitted electronically to Kathryn Craig:
